The baby is otherwise acting normal although mom think it is hard for her to stool. The mom brings her to see the baby's pediatrician. The pediatrician sees the patient, and sees the results of the newborn screen which indicate severe congenital hypothyroidism. At this point, the mother is concerned about the test and has questions; it is normal? What is the treatment? How will the medication need to be administered? Will it interact with any medications? How long will the baby need treatment? How often will the baby need monitoring?
